

Directions

Hampton Inn is located at the interchange of I-49 and La. Hwy. 6 (I-49 exit #138 - hotel on northwest corner).

To NSU from Hotel:

Turn left from hotel onto Hwy 6 east. Go under I-49 and continue on La. 6 for approximately 4 miles.

After coming down the big hill, you will go straight on Business 6 (University Pkwy).

At the fourth stoplight, turn right onto Central Ave. (right before RR crossing).

Go past a parking lot on your right. The new part of Fredericks Building will be the two story brick and white concrete building on your right. Registration will be inside the glass entrance closest to the road and parking.

From Fredericks Building, NSU to the Landing Restaurant banquet:

Go down Central Ave. towards University Pkwy. Go straight through the stoplight and over the RR tracks. Street name changes to 2nd St. Proceed on 2nd St. into town. Turn right onto Church St. (corner with Fire Station, Old Courthouse, and Immaculate Conception Basilica). Go one block and turn right onto Front St. at the stoplight right before the bridge. Park anywhere along Front St. or turn right onto Trudeau St. (one way) and park there or in the lot behind the restaurant. The Landing is located at 530 Front St. facing the Cane River.

For the Upper Elementary Auditions:

The Upper Elementary Auditions will be held in the Louisiana School for Math, Science, and the Arts Recital Hall. LSMSA is located at 715 University Pkwy just beyond the NSU library parking lot and just before the corner of Caspari St. Park in the NSU Library lot or in the small LSMSA lot right next to it (across from Smoothie King and Premium Cuts Hair Salon). Go between the main LSMSA Building and the Music and Art Building (small old Trade School Bldg.) past the fountain and through the courtyard into the newer building - the Center for Performance and Technology. The Recital Hall is off of the lobby next to the Art Gallery.
